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## Publishing opportunities

- **Abstracts** published in the Conference Proceedings
- **Abstracts extended to full papers** and submitted to one of the journals that support the conference

## Possible contents

- final research or part of research you are conducting in your degree programs (PhD or Master)
- the research/work that you did in your previous study (e.g., Bachelor, Master)
- the research/work that you did/do at your work, in the organisation in which you are employed
- other topic of your interest

# Abstract

- Authors can submit **abstracts in the length of 200 to 250 words.**
- The abstract has to be **written in English.**
- The content of the abstract has to be structured including the following **elements:**
  - (i) theoretical background
  - (ii) aim of the study
  - (iii) research methods
  - (iv) central findings with implications

## Presentation of the abstract

- You can either present your abstract live or with a pre-recorded video presentation.
- In either case, **live attendance of the session** is required to enable quality discussion.
- Video presentation can be **recorded with PowerPoint**. This [short instructional video](#) presents how the narration may be done, here you can find [additional instruction](#) on how to do it.
- Preferably, video presentation should be **exported as .mp4 video file or .ppsx PowerPoint file** ([see more information](#)).

# Scientific papers

- **IMRaD structure**
- **Importance of the language** (grammar, uniform vocabulary, logically connected parts of the paper, precise messages, clearly expressing the ideas and concepts)
- **Introduction**
  - Why was the study undertaken? What was the research question, the tested hypothesis or the purpose of the research?
  - what, why, how
- **Methods**
  - When, where, and how was the study done? What materials were used or who was included in the study?
  - data, collection, analysis, assumptions, limitations
- **Results**
  - What answer was found to the research question; what did the study find? Was the tested hypothesis true?
  - established way of reporting
- **Discussion**
  - What might the answer imply and why does it matter? How does it fit in with what other researchers have found? What are the perspectives for future research?



## Double blind review

- Papers can be desk rejected by the editor of the journal
- The process of reviewing takes quite some time
- Carefully read the reviews and do the appropriate changes
- Report the changes
